The East Redding Bike Lanes Project is nearing completion. On August 6, 2013, the Shasta County Board of Supervisors will consider approving a Notice of Completion. A ribbon-cutting ceremony is scheduled at the site.

Redding and Caltrans have existing trail systems along State Route 299 and Shasta View Drive. This project connects and extends those routes beyond the City Limits to Simpson University, Shasta College and Columbia Elementary School.

The next County project will extend these improvements past Columbia Elementary School to Big League Dreams. Thirteen more properties have been acquired and utilities are being relocated for construction in 2014.
